 2. Passes and Eurail tickets may not be purchased, issued or used by residents of Europe, the Russian Federation and Turkey. Once you have lived in the UK, Europe, Russia or Turkey for 6 months you are no longer eligible to use/purchase any Eurail or Britrail ticket or pass product.
 3. Transportation covered by the pass or ticket is subject to the Uniform Rules concerning the contract for International Carriage of Passengers and Luggage by rail (CIV). In the event of carriage by sea, the legal provision of the individual sea carrier applies.
 4. Passes are not valid until the first and last day of validity and passport number are entered by a railway official before travel begins. Usage must begin within six months of the date of issue or as stated on the ticket. Holders are not allowed to validate their own passes.
 5. Eurail tickets may be purchased up to 4 months in advance and are valid for 1 month from the first date of validity as nominated by the passenger at the time of purchase/ticket issue. Passes may be purchased up to 6 months in advance.
