

The perfect pass for exploring the fascinating island of Kyushu. Valid for travel to Fukuoka, Beppu, Mt. Aso, Kumamoto, Miyazaki, Saga, Kagoshima, Nagasaki, Oita and other tourist destinations in the area.

General information

FEATURES

- There is only one class ORDINARY.
- Validity: 3 or 5 consecutive days.
- Children 6 - 11yrs inclusive: special child rate. One child under 6yrs travels free per paying adult.
- The full name of the passenger as per their passport including middle name must be provided.
- A copy of the passenger's passport may be required.

The JR Kyushu is valid on the following:

- Unlimited usage of JR Kyushu trains on Kyushu, including the Kyushu Shinkansen and limited express trains, but excluding the Sanyo Shinkansen (which is operated by JR West).

Sites of Interest which can be visited by this ticket include:

Fukuoka

- Kyushu's largest and most vibrant city, Dazaifu
- Kyushu's former administrative center, Nagasaki
- Attractive port city with a moved history, Kumamoto
- Modern city most famous for its castle, Kagoshima
- Southernmost of Kyushu's major cities, Beppu
- One of Japan's most famous hot spring resorts.

Conditions

To be eligible to purchase a Kyushu Rail Pass, you must meet one of the following 2 criteria.

1. You are a foreign tourist visiting Japan for sightseeing, under the entry status of "temporary visitor". Only persons who have a passport bearing this stamp can use a Sanyo Area Rail Pass.
2. You are a Japanese national living in a foreign country who
 - a) is qualified to live permanently in that country, or
 - b) is married to a non Japanese resident in a country other than Japan.

Note: persons meeting conditions a or b will be required to show proof of the same at the time of purchase.

Validity

An Exchange Order is issued which must be presented in Japan at a JR Station that has a Kyushu Rail Pass Exchange Office. Exchange Orders must be presented within 3 months of issue date for a Kyushu Rail Pass to be issued. The pass is then valid for 1 month.

Passengers travelling on non JR lines must pay respective fares and charges applicable to sections travelled.

All reservations must be made locally in Japan.

Refunds

REISSUES

- To reissue a pass a fee applies: 10% of the pass plus \$20.00

REFUNDS

- An Exchange Order that has not been presented for issuance of a Kyushu Rail Pass must be returned within 12 months from issuing date

- A 25% cancellation fee of the YEN pass price plus GST (only in Australia) applies
- Exchange Orders or JR East Pass will not be reissued or refunded if lost or stolen.
